
For community and countywide map dates refer to the Flood Insurance Study report for this jurisdiction.

Base Map information shown on this FIRM was derived from multiple sources. The FEMA National Flood Hazard Layer (NFHL) data provided base transportation and city limit information, 2014. The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) provided base map data, 2005 - 2010. The Texas Natural Resources Information System (TNRIS) provided the Texas Strategic Mapping Program (StratMap) GIS data for city and corporate boundaries, and transportation layers dated 2014. The City of Grand Prairie provided root files dated 2014. Additional information was photogrammetrically compiled at a scale of at least 1:24000 from aerial photography dated 2013.
